Important Safety Information

Indication

Fluzone Intradermal vaccine is an inactivated influenza virus vaccine indicated for active immunization of persons 18 through 64 years of age against influenza disease caused by influenza virus subtypes A and type B contained in the vaccine.

Safety Information

Erythema, induration, swelling, and pruritus at the vaccination site occur more frequently with Fluzone Intradermal vaccine than with Fluzone vaccine. Other adverse reactions include pain, headache, myalgia, and malaise. Other adverse reactions may occur. Fluzone Intradermal vaccine should not be administered to anyone with a severe allergic reaction (eg, anaphylaxis to any vaccine component, including egg protein, or to a previous dose of any influenza vaccine. The decision to give Fluzone Intradermal vaccine should be based on the potential benefits and risks, especially if Guillain-Barré syndrome has occurred within 6 weeks of receipt of a prior influenza vaccine. Vaccination with Fluzone Intradermal vaccine may not protect all individuals.
